- Pray for Kristen Lalley as she is now back in the United States and seeking to know where God would have her serve next.

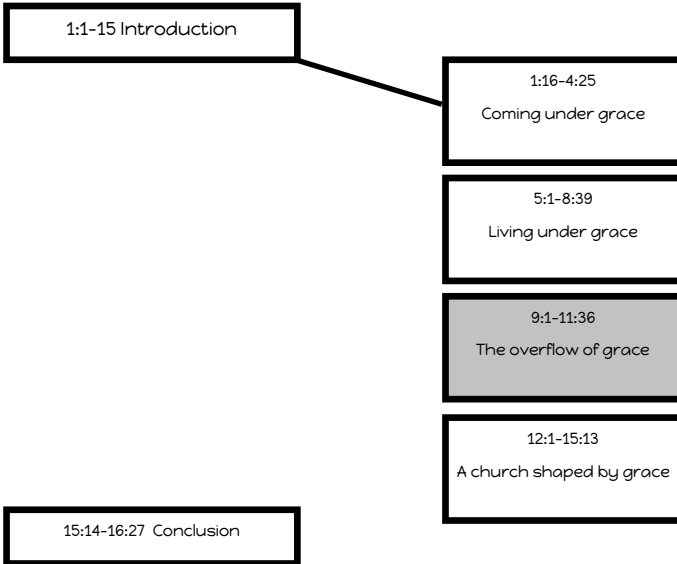
